The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services Wastewater Engineering Bureau Design Review Section ("DES") reviewed the June 2016 Woodard & Curran Report titled "City of Portsmouth Infiltration/Inflow Analysis" ("I/I Study").

DES generally concurs with the I/I Study findings and recommendations. Infiltration and inflow removal projects are typically eligible or partially eligible for funding assistance under DES' State Aid Grant (SAG) and State Revolving Fund (SRF) programs. DES will make eligibility determinations on each individual project as the designs are submitted for review. To maintain funding eligibility, please be sure to follow the DES design review, procurement, contract and bidding procedures for all projects.
