Newcastle Avenue Reconstruction Project

The purpose of the meeting is to present the proposed final design of the Newcastle Avenue Roadway and Seawall Reconstruction Project and to receive public input on the plans. The project includes the reconstruction of approximately ¼ mile of Newcastle Avenue between Marcy Street and the bridge located just east of Pleasant Point Drive as well as the reconstruction of Marcy Street for a distance of approximately 250 feet west of its intersection with Newcastle Avenue. The project scope also includes:

- Reconstruction of approximately 1,100 linear feet of seawall;
- Reconstruction of existing roadway, sidewalks and granite curbing;
- Traffic operational improvements at the intersection of Newcastle Avenue, Marcy Street and Fernald Court;
- Installation of new decorative railing and lighting;

Primary goals of the project include restoring the structural integrity of the seawall, roadway and sidewalks, improving bicycle and pedestrian safety, and enhancing the aesthetic and scenic qualities of the corridor.
