

THE CITY OF PORTSMOUTH SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT ON FUTURE
IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ROUTE 33 CORRIDOR FROM PEVERLY
HILL ROAD TO BORTHWICK AVENUE

The NH Department of Transportation and the City of Portsmouth are beginning the engineering work needed to develop preliminary plans for future improvements to the Railroad Bridge & approaches from Peverly Hill Road to Griffin Road. Before proceeding with the necessary engineering work, the Department and the City want to hear from local drivers and residents.

A Public Informational Meeting and Workshop will be held on Tuesday December 13, 2005 at the Portsmouth Public Works Department in the 1st Floor Conference Room (Located at 680 Peverly Hill Road). The meeting will be from 6 to 7 PM to review the existing conditions plan and then from 7 to 9:00 PM City representatives and the City's consultant will listen to comments and concerns, answer questions and make sure all project related issues are being discussed.

Items to be discussed at this meeting include issues such as public safety, pedestrian, bicyclist, traffic and bridge construction.

Anyone with an interest in the project is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.
