- 1 Parking on corners of intersections, especially those with bump outs
- 2 Speed - establish a speed and post it
- 3 possible define parking spaces with pavement markings
- 4 sidewalks are in poor condition
- 5 sweep the streets more often
- 6 street lighting
- 7 street lighting in the park at night
- 8 encouraging those that have off-street parking to use it
- 9 Long term parking (ie over a week)
- 10 Landlords that don't offer off-street parking
- 11 commercial vs residential parking
- 12 downtown employees park in neighborhood (resident only parking stickers)

- 19 homeless presence along the water

- 23 parking on Islington at Cronwall causes vehicles not to see pedestrians in cw

- 25 homeless presence in park between State St and Islington Street
- 26 illegal parking on Brewster street at the corner with Islington St
- 27 Add crosswalk on Brewster and Langdon Street at Islington

- 29 vehcular sight distance at the intersection of Bridge at Hanover
- 30 crosswalk on Islington between Bridge and Tanner
- 31 define crosswalk on Islington between Pearl and Rock
- 32 Street lighting on Sudbury
- 33 one way vs two way on Brewster Street
- 34 Parking on Brewster between Hanover and Sudbury
- 35 trim tress for sight distance to turn, to see stop signs
- 36 what will the City be doing with the property off of "Rock Street Ext"
- 37 Define parking on "Rock Street Ext" near the Park
- 38 Parking on Brewster north of Sudbury near the Park
- 39 Look at "sidewalk" through park - material is washing into Brewster Street
