I. CALL TO ORDER:

- (A) **Livermore Street** - Request for Resident Parking – Steve Parkinson stated the Traffic & Safety Committee went there regarding parking on both sides of the street. The Committee voted to recommend parking only on the northerly side of Livermore St. and the minutes were accepted by the City Council and an Ordinance change will be made. While the Committee members were at Livermore St. some of the residents requested resident parking only. During the day people parking on Livermore St. work downtown or at the Wentworth Home making it difficult for residents to park. The residents would like to have a parking space when they get home at night, and are looking for a time period. The City Manager suggested that the City’s Parking Consultant should be brought back and have an open meeting inviting City Council members, Police Chief Magnant, Deputy Police Chief DiSesa, Fred Hoysradt, Debbie Finnigan and Downtown Business Association. Steve Parkinson suggested making copies of the report and distribute them in order to get comments back. City Manager suggested having a teleconference and have City staff here and invite people and discuss it in a work session. The Chair suggested tabling this until the report is completed.

MOTION made by Steve Parkinson to table this until the report is completed. Seconded by Police Captain Champlin. Motion passed.
