As you know, over the last several months the City has been working with your neighborhood and CLD Consulting Engineers on the Atlantic Heights Traffic Circulation Analysis and Raleigh Way Streetscape Improvement Project. Raleigh Way is the latest street in the neighborhood to be re-designed, however, no funding has been allocated yet for the construction phase.
