1. Minimum Impact Expedited Application 650 Borthwick Avenue Fairfield Inn Portsmouth FFI, LLC, owner Assessor Map 234, Lot 7-6

III. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT APPLICATIONS

A. Conditional Use Permit Application 650 Borthwick Avenue Fairfield Inn Portsmouth FFI, LLC, owner Assessor Map 234, Lot 7-6

The Commission voted to recommend approval of the application to the Planning Board with the following stipulations:

- 1) That scheduled parking lot maintenance, to include sweeping and catch basin clean up, happen at least twice a year (spring and fall).
- 2) That hotel maintenance staff participate in a brief presentation on stormwater management, to include swale maintenance.
- 3) That a natural shrub buffer is maintained along the edge of the swale closest to the hotel, an area currently consisting of mowed lawn.
- B. Conditional Use Permit Application 187 Wentworth Road Witch Cove Marina Development, LLC J.P. Nadeau, owner Assessor Map 201, Lots 17 & 18

The Commission voted to deny recommending approval of the application to the Planning Board for the following reasons:

- 1) The Commission felt it was an over-intensive use of the site resulting in excessive parking.
- 2) More information was needed on the repair or replacement of the culvert pipe.
- 3) More information was needed on the retaining wall.
