- VI. OLD BUSINESS
  - i. JSN UPDATE BUILDING SETTLEMENT Jeff Nawrocki updated the committee on slab reinforcement and building settlement issues. A section of the first floor hallway slab has been reinforced with shoring posts. The second issue is one of building settlement in the 1930's wing. Mr. Nawrocki reassured the committee that the building is structurally sound and safe for occupants. There are however several areas that appear to be experiencing additional settlement. A plan to measure the type and degree of settlement will commence on Saturday. The data provided will determine whether additional remedial measures will be required.

Mr. Carrier expressed concern regarding the duration of the data collection, and asked who would be responsible for monitoring, and any adjustments after the building is complete.
