Safe Routes to School Project

Next week, the City will be kicking of a project to make travel along a critical section of Route 1 safer and more appealing for pedestrians and bicyclists of all ages. Initially identified in the City's Safe Routes to School Action Plan in 2010, this project was also highlighted as a high priority in the City's recently completed Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.

The project, which received funding from the NHDOT Safe Routes to School Program, will evaluate options for creating an on-road bike route along Route 1 between the High School and Downtown. Pedestrian crossings at the intersections along this corridor will also be assessed to determine where improvements might be necessary to improve safety and accessibility.

A public meeting to discuss the project is scheduled for Wednesday, November 19th at 7pm at the Portsmouth Middle School.
