










2009 - Consent Decree 2010 - Wastewater System Master Plan








# 2014/2015 Pease Wastewater Option Evaluation







### Peirce Island Road Bridge

- Constructed 1958
- Typical Lifespan 50 Years
- Plan for Replacement
- Could be Eligible for NHDOT Municipal Bridge Aid Program with 80% Grant Funding
- Potential Replacement Cost \$7M



# Peirce Island Road Bridge

- Condition Assessment Results:
  - Showing Signs of Age
  - Deck MaintenanceNeeded





### Peirce Island Road Bridge

- Deck Maintenance Project
  - Extend Life to Take Advantage of DOT Funding
  - Avoid Repairs During WWTF Construction
- Estimated Cost Range: \$500,000 to \$800,000
- Schedule: 6 Months (to Sept 2016)
- Maintenance Project Impacts
  - One Way Alternating Traffic
  - Restricted Lane Width
