The applicant is proposing to:

- Reestablish a metal (black aluminum) fence and archway that was previously located on the raised planters. A non-locking gate is proposed to be located under the archway.
- The fence will be 4 1/2 feet tall and sit on the planter wall.
- At the last meeting in January, the HDC requested an alternative design for the gate/ archway portion of the fence.
- The applicant has requested to postpone this agenda item to the March 2nd meeting

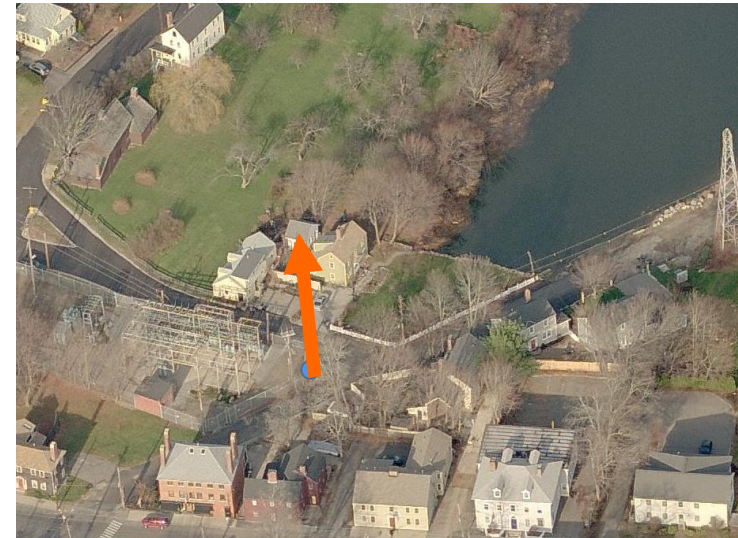

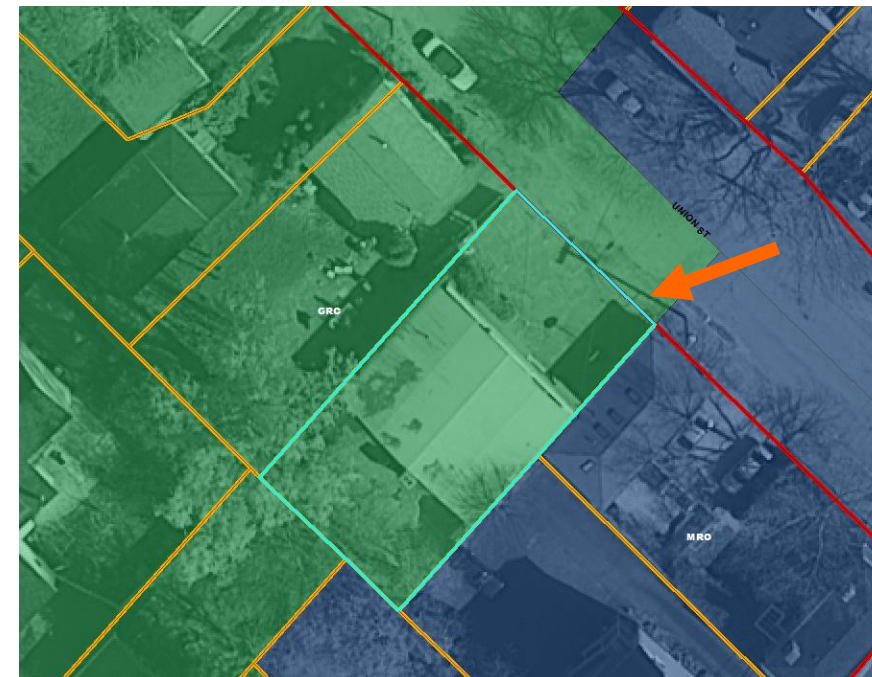

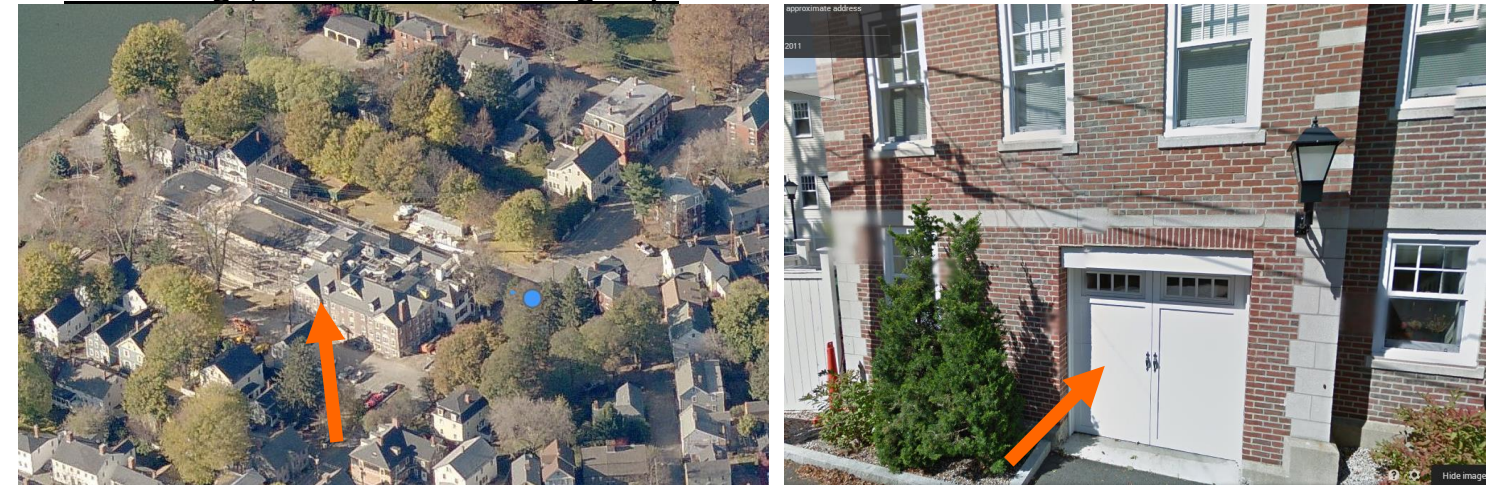

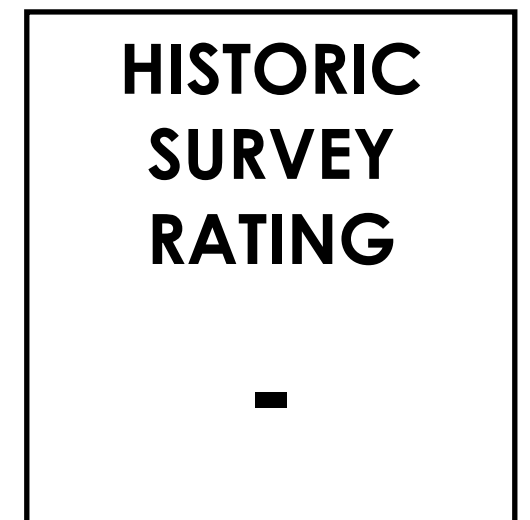
