PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. Petition of Portsmouth Housing Authority, owner, for property located at 444 Pleasant Street, wherein permission is requested to allow renovations to existing structures (repair multiple entryways: cover concrete steps with composite material and replace existing porch supports and overhang) as per plans on file in the Planning Department. Said property is shown on Assessor Map 102 as Lot 54 and lies within the General Residence B (GRB) and Historic Districts.

A. Work Session requested by Charles J. Silvia Jr. and Margaret M. Moran, owners, for property located at 434 Marcy Street, wherein permission is requested to allow new construction to an existing structure (create 2nd floor and attic addition over existing 1-story footprint with overhang, create a 1-story rear entry and bay addition with new landing and stairs, and remove and replace existing shed) as per plans on file in the Planning Department. Said property is shown on Assessor Map 102 as Lot 41 and lies within the General Residence B (GRB) and Historic Districts.
