LETTERS OF INTENT DUE

- Wednesday, October 1 at noon
 - Notices of Intent to Apply for FY25 are due. Letters of Intent are REQUIRED if you want to be invited to officially apply for a FY25 Grant.

CONVERSATION WITH DHR STAFF

- Weeks of October 1st through October 10th
 - Follow-up virtual meetings with DHR staff to discuss proposed application's strengths and weaknesses and how to make your application competitive

INVITATIONS TO APPLY

- October 10th
 - DHR will send invitations to apply following discussions with those that submitted Letters of Intent.

FULL APPLICATIONS DUE

- Friday, December 5th at noon
 - Full FY25 Applications due by noon (a separate email will be sent with instructions after Letters of Intent are received)

AWARD NOTIFICATIONS MADE

- Friday, December 12th
 - Pending release of Federal funding, awards will be made and Grant Agreements will be sent for Grant Recipients to complete.

COMPLETED GRANT AGREEMENTS DUE

- Friday, February 13th at noon
 - Completed Grant Agreements are due by this day. If completed Grant Agreements are not received OR a request for extension is not submitted to and approved by DHR Staff, the project cannot move forward in the FY25 cycle.
