**INFORMATION SESSIONS**

- Thursday, August 14 at 6:30 PM
- Thursday, August 21 at noon

**LETTERS OF INTENT DUE**

- **Wednesday, October 1 at noon**
  - Notices of Intent to Apply for FY25 are due. Letters of Intent are REQUIRED if you want to be invited to officially apply for a FY25 Grant.

**CONVERSATION WITH DHR STAFF**

- **Weeks of October 1st through October 10th**
  - Follow-up virtual meetings with DHR staff to discuss proposed application's strengths and weaknesses and how to make your application competitive

**INVITATIONS TO APPLY**

- **October 10th**
  - DHR will send invitations to apply following discussions with those that submitted Letters of Intent.

**FULL APPLICATIONS DUE**

- **Friday, December 5th at noon**
  - Full FY25 Applications due by noon (a separate email will be sent with instructions after Letters of Intent are received)

**AWARD NOTIFICATIONS MADE**

- **Friday, December 12th**
  - Pending release of Federal funding, awards will be made and Grant Agreements will be sent for Grant Recipients to complete.

**COMPLETED GRANT AGREEMENTS DUE**

- **Friday, February 13th at noon**
  - Completed Grant Agreements are due by this day. If completed Grant Agreements are not received OR a request for extension is not submitted to and approved by DHR Staff, the project cannot move forward in the FY25 cycle.
