Wind-Powered Energy Systems Exemption
RSA 72:65, 66

72:65 Definition of Wind-Powered Energy Systems. – In this subdivision "wind-powered energy system" means any wind-powered devices which supplement or replace electrical power supplied to households or businesses at the immediate site.

72:66 Exemption for Wind-Powered Energy Systems. – Each city and town may adopt under RSA 72:27-a an exemption from the assessed value, for property tax purposes, for persons owning real property which is equipped with a wind-powered energy system.

RESOLUTION #21-2018:

"...If qualified, for persons owning real property equipped with a wind-powered energy system as defined in RSA 72:65, the City shall exempt from taxes an amount equal to the assessed value of the wind-powered energy system..."

HOW TO APPLY

To apply for The Wind-Powered Energy Systems Exemption, visit the Assessor's Office to sign a PA-29 Permanent Application. Bring your photo ID. If your property is in a trust, please also bring a copy of the trust.

FILING DEADLINE

The filing deadline is by April 15th preceding the setting of the tax rate. Example: If you are applying for an exemption off your 2024 property taxes, which are due no earlier than December 1, 2024 then you have until April 15, 2025 to file this form.
