

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On June 15, the newly formed Citizens response Task Force made a plea to the city council to fully support and fund recovery efforts such as expanded outdoor dining and the Pop Up (then Rooftop) project. They talked about the goals of the project to "save businesses, provide jobs, and provide safe options for the public." They stressed that the city needed to "move fast, not try to be perfect out of the start, and adjust on the fly as needed." Senator Martha Fuller Clark also spoke to Council at that evening, stating these efforts were a "plea for arts and culture" and that the city should be prepared to "modify and move forward" as needed.

And pivot the Pop Up working group did. Changing venue, changing capacity, configuration, forming a nonprofit, even narrowing the focus from 'local' to 'Portsmouth' based businesses. Even with opening dates pushed back, the team moved forward.

The Task Force chairs informed the Council how the community came together to support the arts and business community, giving their time and expertise to the city for free. They expressed the enormous good will and positive energy behind these efforts. Donations exceeded expectations.

Now look at our community. Look what chaos one person can cause. Contradictory to all information provided to her in her official capacity as a council member, Esther Kennedy invented her own reality and torpedoed the Pop Up project with intent to sink it.

But she didn't sink it. The volunteers are too focused and dedicated. The city support, including the Task Force, is too professional. But the community is listing. Arguments are breaking out, accusations, based on her misinformation campaign, are being hurled at one another. Let's not let Esther win.
