This addendum forms part of the original document marked **"07-20 Replacement of Portsmouth High School Track"**

The following questions have been asked and answers provided:

Question 1: Base Bid states identify estimated square footage of patching.

• Can a square footage be determined for bidding purposes? We cannot determine the square footage until the track surface is removed or the nature of the blacktop repair itself, full depth or mill and pave?

W&S Response: The plans show the estimated areas of concern, the Contractor shall bid accordingly to cover these areas. Contractor shall include Square foot Unit Price for adding or subtracting scope of these areas.

Question 2: Add Alternate 3 states additional asphalt pavement repairs.

• Can a square footage be determined for bidding purposes? We cannot determine the square footage until the track surface is removed or the nature of the blacktop repair itself, full depth or mill and pave?

W&S Response: Areas of Additional asphalt shown on plans are not exact. Areas were explained during the Pre-Bid Meeting and site walk. Contractor shall include square foot Unit Price for paving additional areas outside what is shown on the plans.

Question 3: Will the liquidated damages be waved due to poor weather conditions; polyurethane track systems are extremely weather sensitive?

W&S Response: Contractor shall bid according to current specifications and timeline. Once awarded the City is open to further discussion of extending the timeline if weather proves to be excessive. Contractor to provide adequate manpower to stay on schedule.

Question 4: What is the scope of work at the D-zone?

W&S Response: D-zones shall be protected during the length of construction. No work to be done on these areas.

Question 5: What is the scope of work pertaining to Add Alternate 2?

W&S Response: Once base bid has been completed Add Alt #2 shall consist of all necessary operations to properly apply the 2-coat polyurethane system spray- color: RED per manufacturers recommendations and specifications.

Question 6: Our track installation crew works overtime and weekends; can the time and day restrictions be eliminated?

W&S Response: Contractor shall bid according to current specifications and timeframe. Once awarded the City is open to further discussion of extending the current workday and times. Contractor to provide adequate manpower to stay on schedule.

Question 7: There is only a slight chance our schedule will allow for the track surface to be installed this year, can we write "No Bid" for the based bid and bid the alternate only?

W&S Response: The City will not accept this.

The following changes have been to the plans:

Add Alternate #4: In place of patch work at areas of concern, Contractor shall R&D surface and mill and overlay with pavement the entire bit base to 2" depth, as there seemed to be no major planarity issues.

Bidders are to acknowledge this addendum within their proposals. Failure to do so may subject a bidder to disqualification.
