INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bid proposals, **plainly marked, Demolition of the Islington Street Water Tank Bid Number 12-07 on the outside of the mailing envelope as well as the sealed bid envelope**, addressed to the Finance/Purchasing Department, City Hall, 1 Junkins Avenue, Portsmouth, New Hampshire, 03801, will be accepted until 2:00 pm., October 23, 2006 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

This project consists of the demolition and removal of the Islington Street Water Tank at the corner of Islington and Essex Streets and appurtenances. This tank reached the end of its useful life. It was originally constructed in 1892 and was last coated in 1991 at which time all lead base paint had been removed.

Each Bidder shall furnish a bid security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid. The Bid Security may be in the form of a certified bank check or a bid bond executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Hampshire, made payable to the City of Portsmouth, NH.

The City of Portsmouth reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive technical or legal deficiencies, and to accept any bid that it may deem to be in the best interest of the City.
