Bid 23-25 Traffic Signal Replacement

Question 1: Mast Arms- Plan notes call for natural finish while special provision calls for powder coated black over galvanized. Please clarify coating and color of mast arms.

Answer: The intent is that all equipment is black per the Portsmouth downtown standard. All mast arms therefore are to be power-coated black as described in the special provisions. Ignore the natural finish notes on the plan.

Question 2: Pedestrian Poles- Plan notes call for natural finish while special provisions call for powder coated black over galvanized steel. Ped poles are typically aluminum. Please clarify type of metal and coating for pedestrian poles.

Answer: All pedestrian poles are to be galvanized steel powder coated black. Steel poles and bases are desired here because of the tight spaces involved on the street corners.

Question 3: Is the green depicted on the striping plans thermoplastic, or standard pavement paint?

Answer: This item is paid under retroreflective paint words and symbol markings (632.02) in the base bid and thermoplastic words and symbol marking (632.32) under Add-Alt 3. It is paid by the square foot in both scenarios.
