Next Year's FY21 Budgets

At the time of publication of the PAFR for year ending June 30, 2020, Fiscal Year 2021 is underway and the budget document is available for review at the Public Library, City document is available for revew at the Public Library, City (cirk's office as well as on the City's website. This budget was carefully prepared in light of the uncertainties of the COVID-p pandment.
